The map on the facing page describes the Parishes within the Archdeaconry of Doncaster. Although D&DFHS concentrates on this area, our Research Centre holds material from a much wider area, as well as providing free access to a number of websites.

### Parish CD Collection

Each CD in this series contains transcriptions of baptisms, marriages and burials taken from the parish registers, the dates covered are shown on the table. In addition, they contain a selection of other material which will be very useful for family historians such as monumental inscriptions, histories of the parish, descriptions of the church, parish directories eg Kelly's, cemetery plans, War Memorials, even oddments such as School admissions and Pilgrim Fathers on a couple of them, photographs and, occasionally, the Dade registers (if they were kept) and a few Catholic registers or census.

### Baptism Collection on CD All @ £9.00 each and weighing 90g

Each Baptism CD gives details such as forename(s) of the child, name(s) of parents, surname, and occupation of father, date of baptism, address and any other details which are shown on the actual registers - such as date of birth, illegitimate, etc. The 'Dade Register' where available shows transcriptions of the original registers and often contains even more information such as the grandparents names, occupations and abodes. **Some include other details such as school registers of Kelly's directories and well worth checking** – these extras where included are shown with the title below.

The burials of the Snaith and Hatfield Deanery are covered by two volumes. Volume 1 contains the following parishes: Fenwick 1871-1950, Fishlake 1561-1919, Hatfield 1566-1943, Kirk Bramwith 1700-1971, Moss 1876-1955, Sykehouse MIs & Thorne 1565-1896.

The burial registers for Sykehouse were stolen and never recovered. The inscriptions from the headstones were transcribed by volunteers in 1985 and these have been included on this CD. Also includes maps showing position of the headstones.

Stainforth and Duncroft are 'modern' churches that were created out of the parish of Hatfield. They do not have their own burial ground. A council run cemetery opened in Stainforth c1888, monumental inscriptions and burial entries from those registers are on a separate CD.

Each monumental inscription and register entry include a reference to the section each grave can be found. A selection of photos and a map showing the position of the sections are also included.

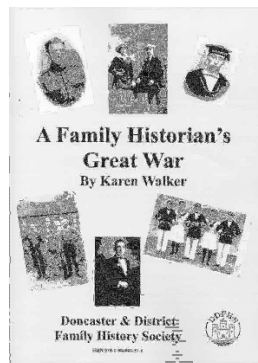
